SEMINAR OPTIONS

Below you will find the details of a typical seminar. If there are ways we can adapt these details to fit the needs of your church/ community, we would love to do so. Our prayer is that we can partner together to help more people find emotional and spiritual freedom.

Scheduling

Scheduling a seminar should be done at least 4-6 months in advance.

Format

Our typical format is four 2-3 hour sessions, with each session divided into two parts by a short break, covering a total of 8 topics.

Topics

Topics focus on helping people find emotional healing as well as understanding how the spiritual issues are related to the emotional issues. Possible session topics include:

- Understanding Our Hearts
- Understanding and Resolving Shame
- Overcoming Criticism and/or Self Focus
- Overcoming Depression
- Grace vs. Performance
- How My View of God Affects My Identity
- What Determines My Value?
- Choosing the Path of Grace

Venue

We typically prefer an informal setting with tables to make note-taking easier. Having snacks and drinks tend to help people relax.

Counseling Sessions

We offer individual 2-hour personal sessions free of charge. We ask interested individuals to take a Taylor Johnson assessment prior to our coming for the seminar. Preferably, the local coordinator would oversee this. If there appears to be enough interest in counseling, we would be willing to stay a few days after the seminar as needed.

HOST CHURCH RESPONSIBILITIES

Provision

- Venue for seminar
- Snacks for seminar attendees
- Hotel/AirBnb lodging for seminar speaking couple and at least 2 support staff
- Meals for seminar speakers/helpers
- Counseling location (as needed)

Preparation

- We can provide posters and brochures for you to inform locals of the seminar
- We encourage showing your congregation some sample clips prior to the seminar. We can provide some options for this.

Expense

We do not charge a set price for seminars, but request that our team's travel expenses, lodging, and meals be covered as well as a freewill offering be taken for HOPE Ministries.
